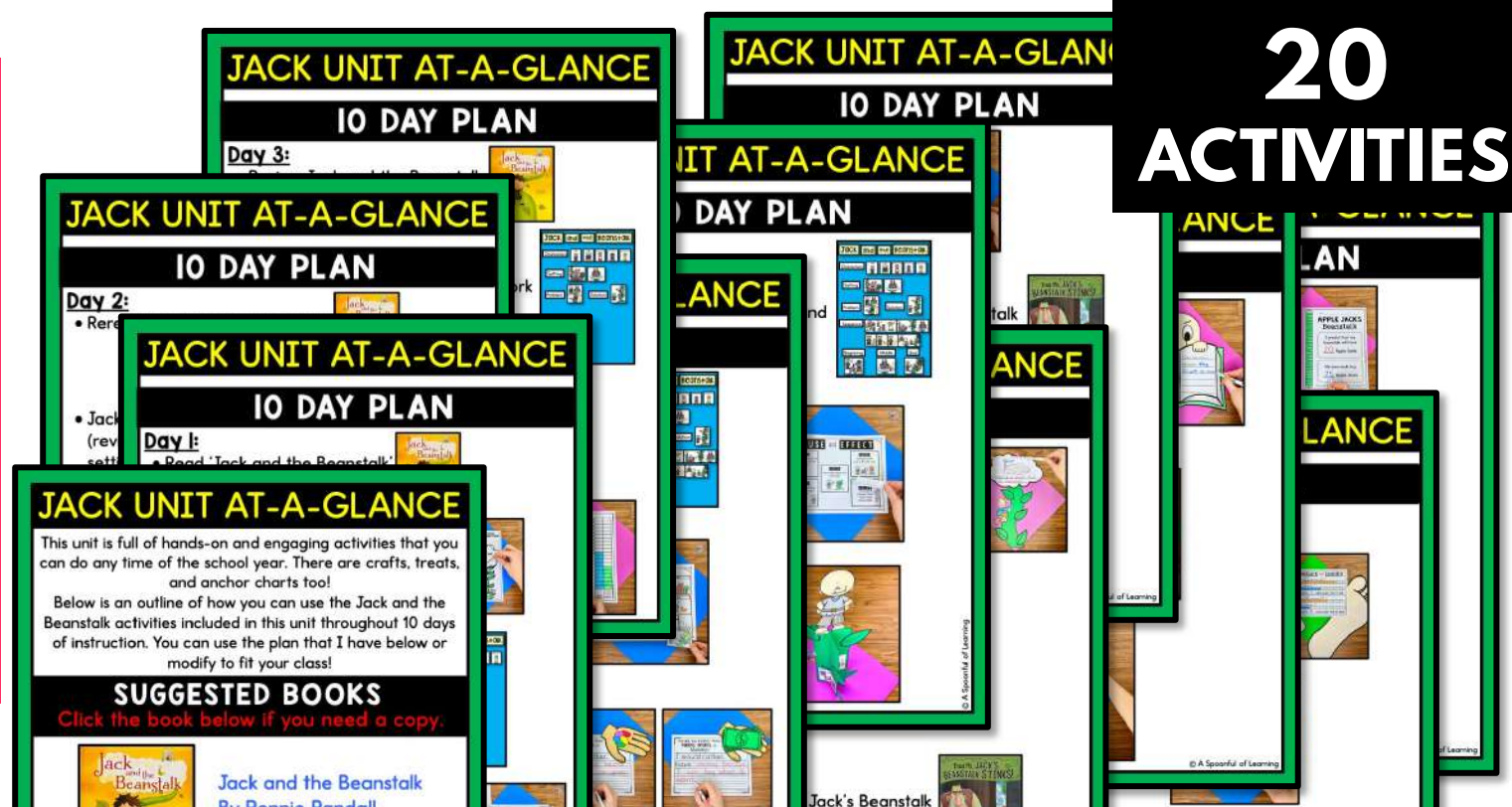

STORY PREDICTION

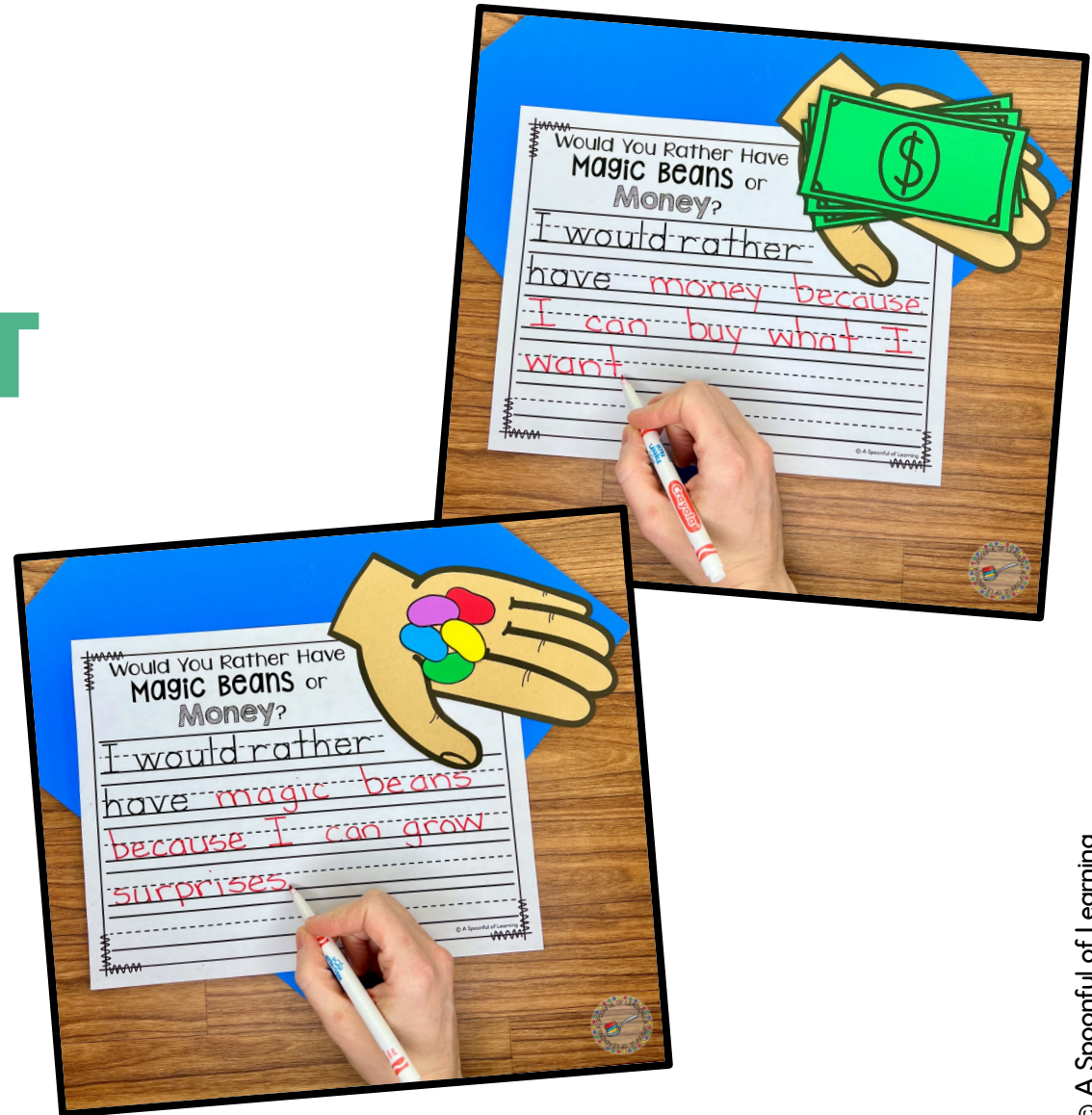
Students will predict what they think Jack will find at the top of the beanstalk before that part is revealed in the story.

Dive deep into the story and learn about the different story elements. This interactive student book focuses on the characters, setting, problem/solution, sequencing, and cause/effect.

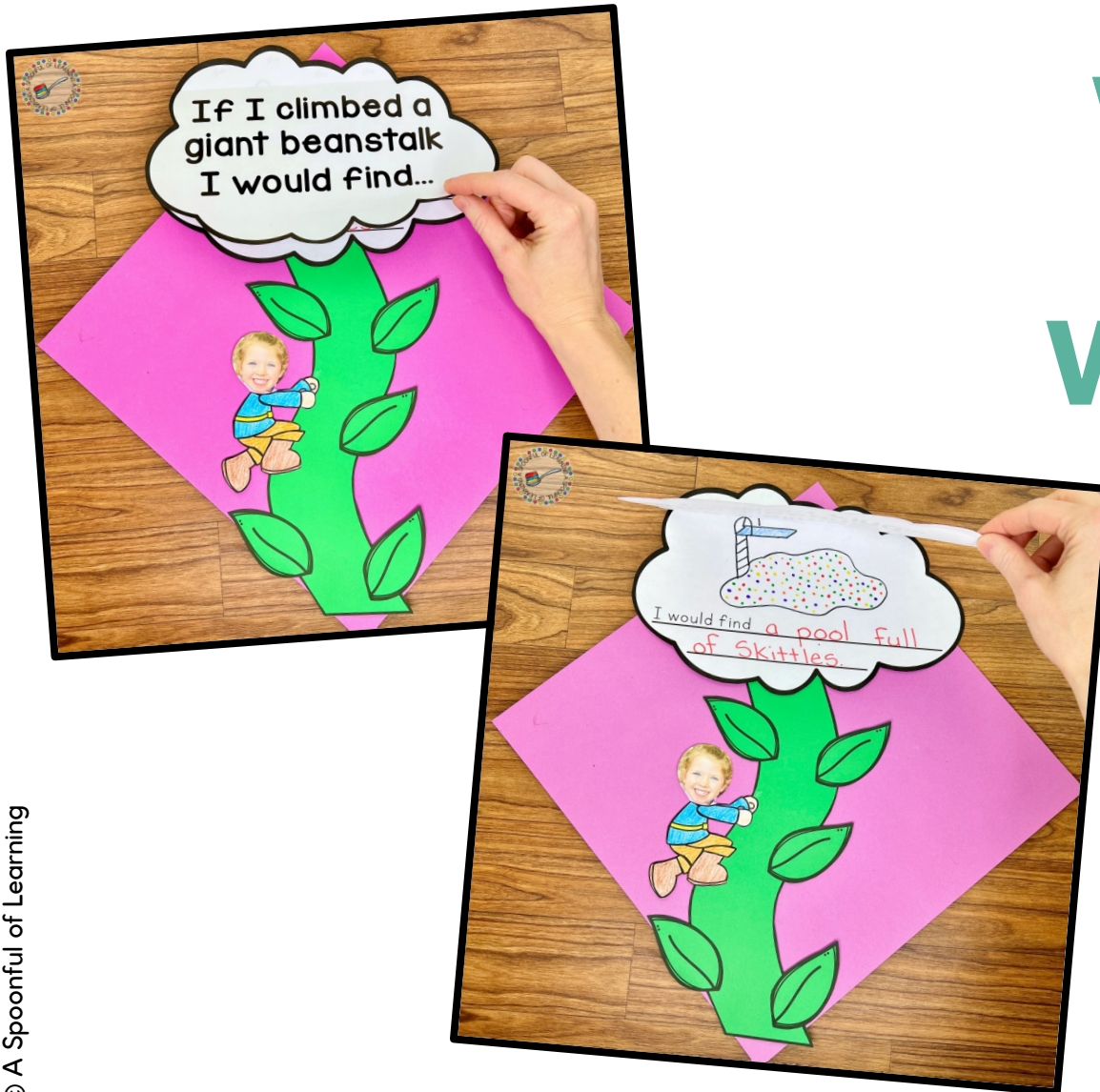

Students get to do some creative and imaginative thinking by writing about what they would find if they climbed a giant beanstalk.

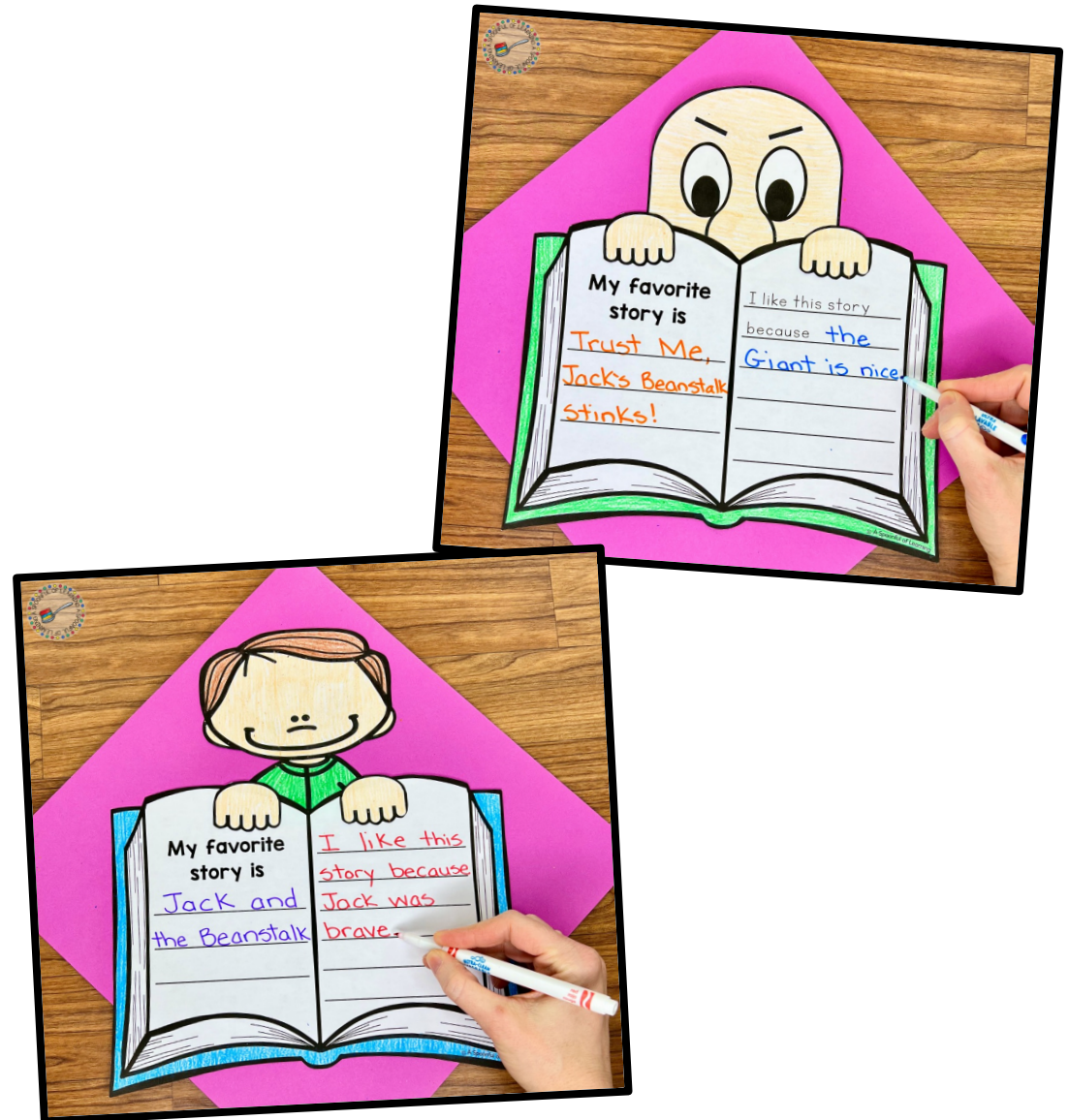

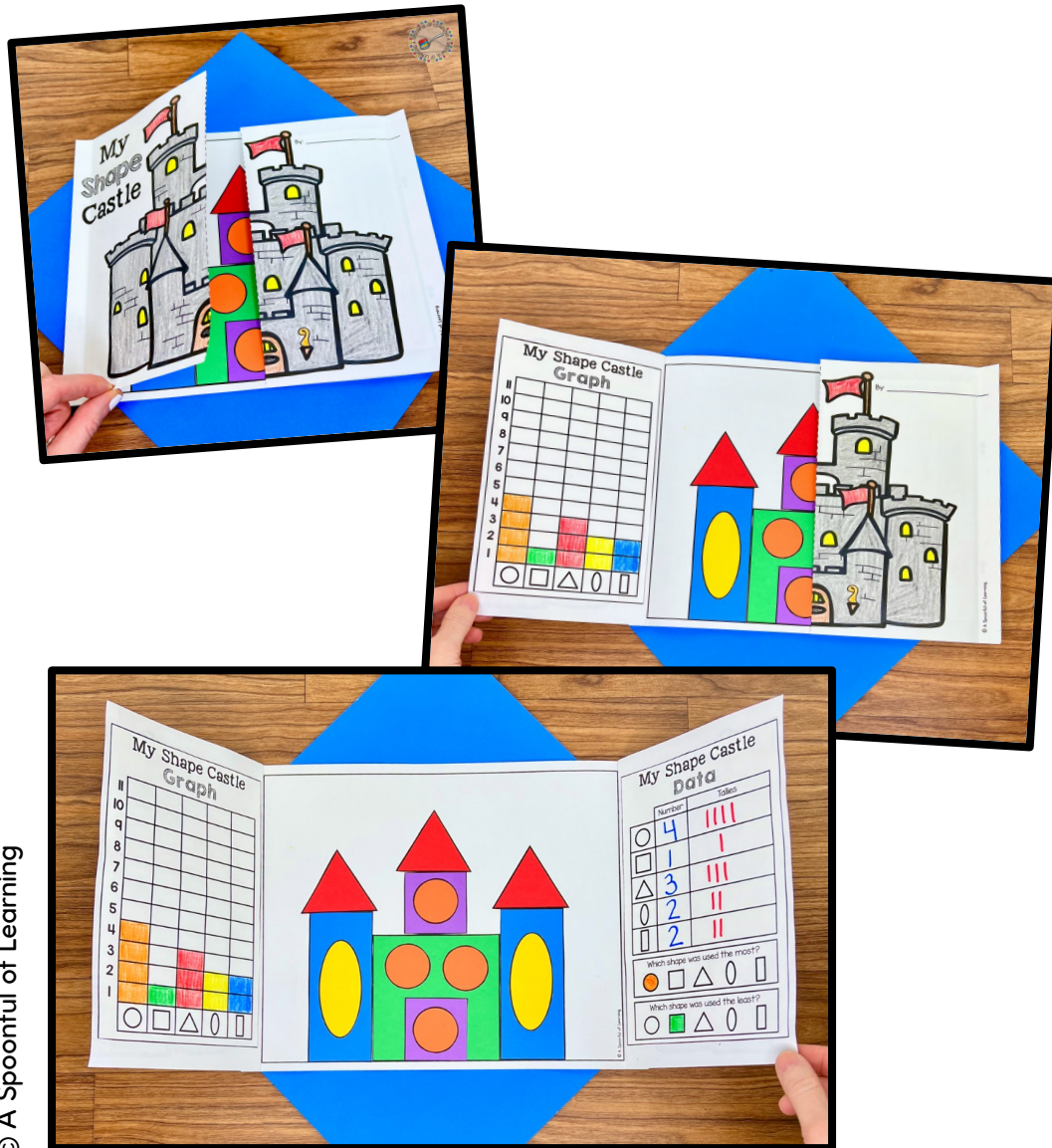
FAVORITE STORY

Write about what you would buy with magic beans. Turn all of the students writing into a class book and add it to your classroom library for everyone to enjoy.

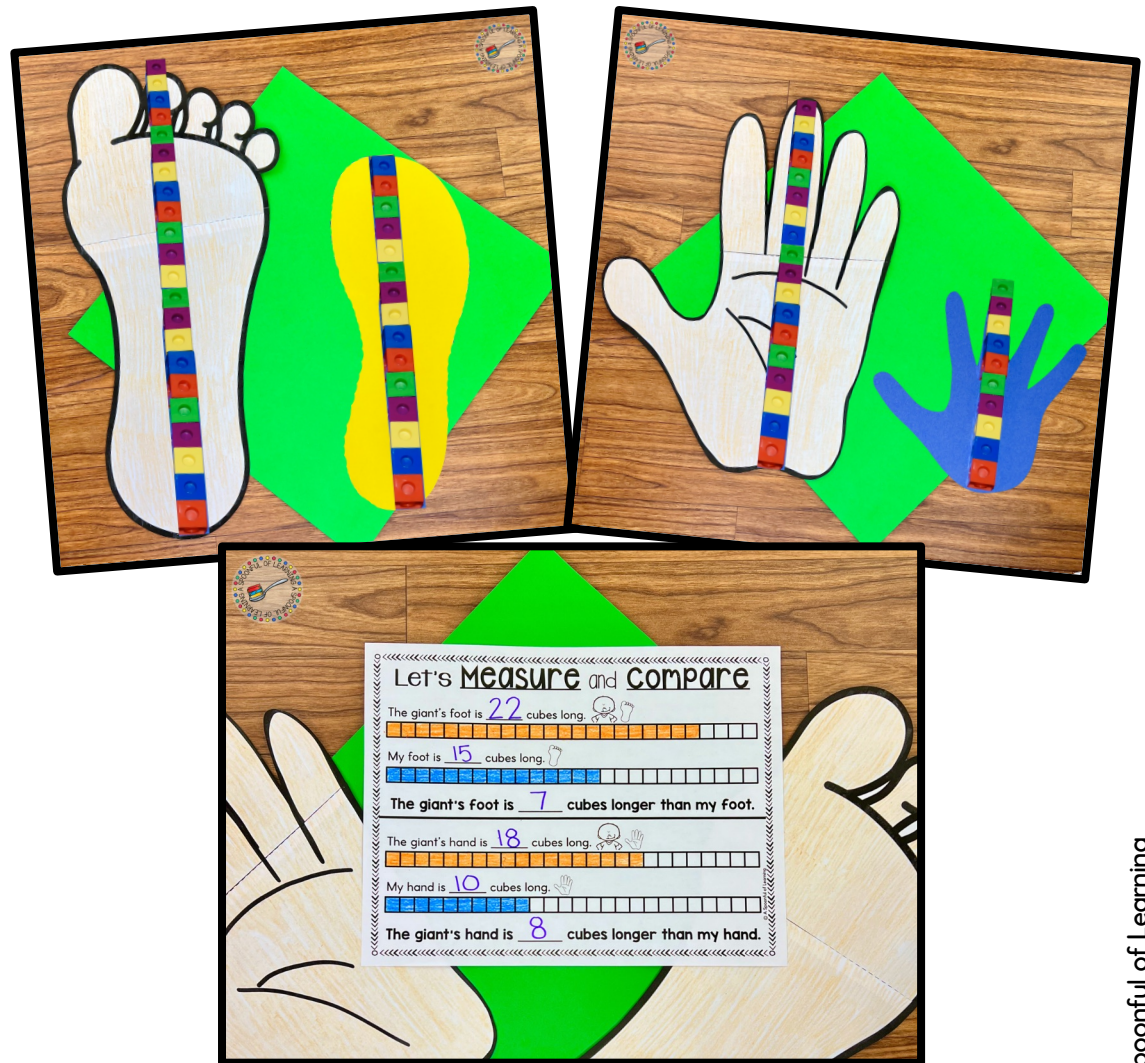

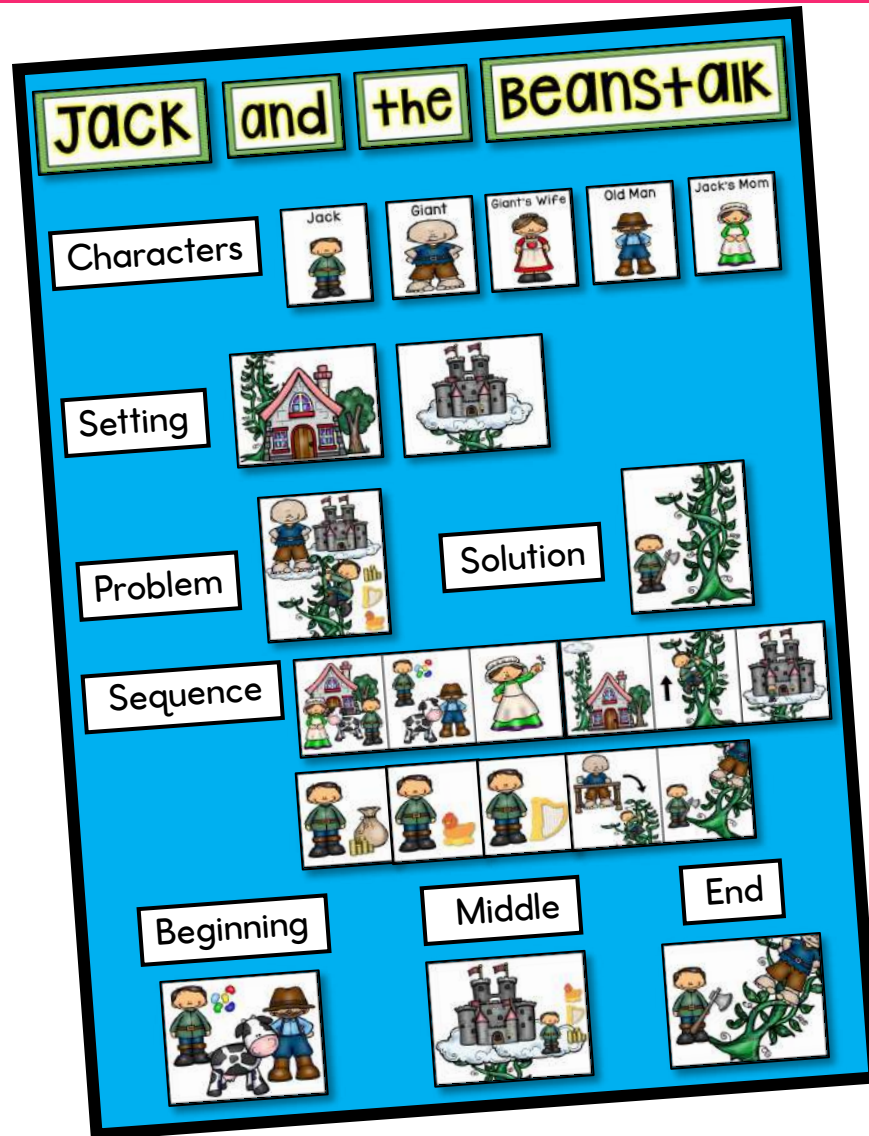
GIANT HAND & FOOT COMPARE

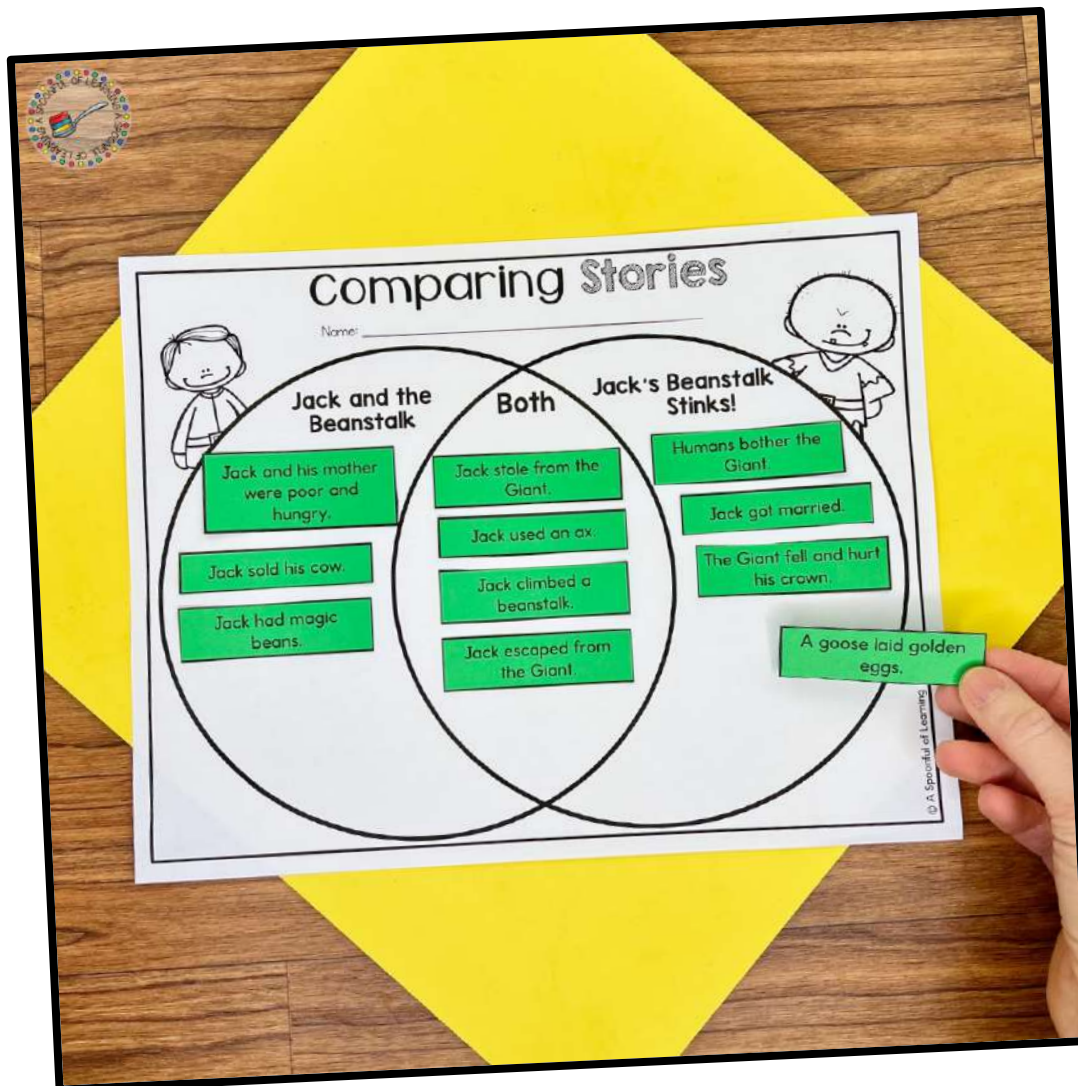
STORY RETELLING

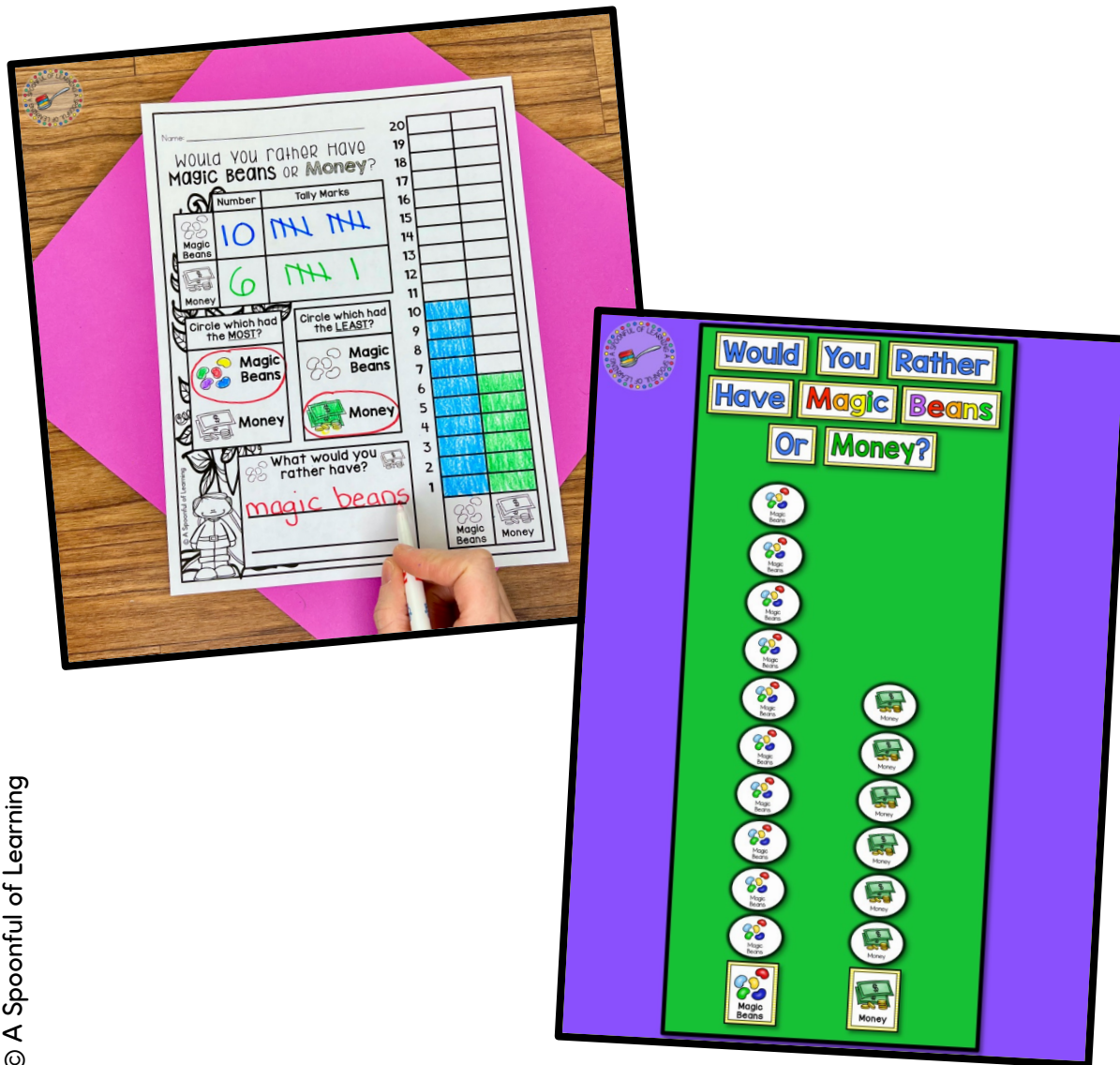

REAL VS. FANTASY

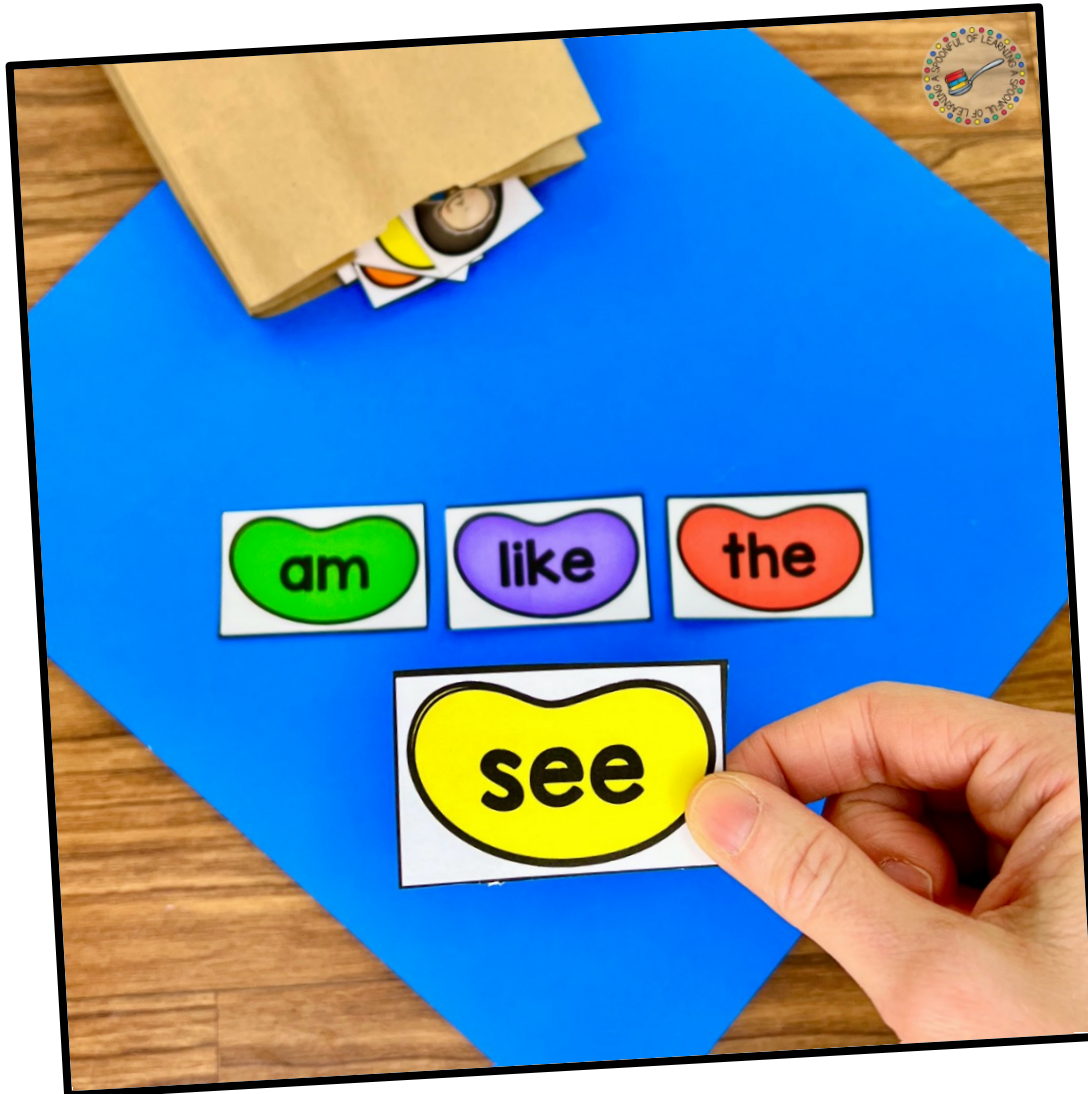
Sort different objects and characters from the story to show if they are real or fantasy.

MAGIC BEANS GAME

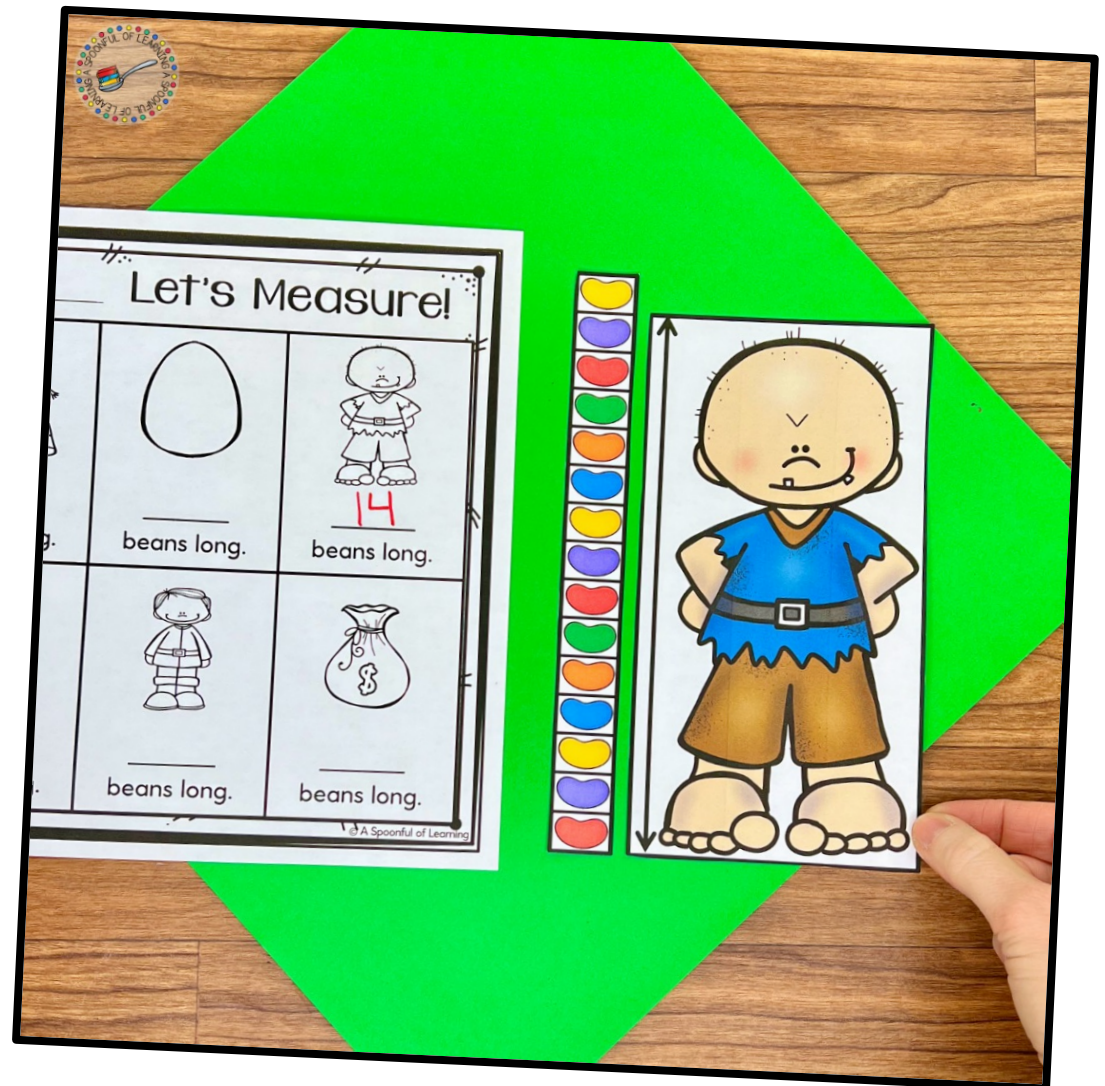
