Literacy and Math Activities, Anchor Charts, Crafts, Games and MORE!!



JACK and the BEANSTALK

This pack is FULL of fun, hands-on, and interactive activities that go along with the classic fairy tale, 'Jack and the Beanstalk'. There are literacy and math activities, anchor charts, crafts, and MORE!

The activities in this unit go along with these stories:

- 'Jack and the Beanstalk' (version of your choice)
- 'Trust Me, Jack's Beanstalk Stinks!' by Eric Braun

ALL colored images and pages also come in black and white.

Here is what is included:

- **Jack and the Beanstalk Story Map Anchor Chart**
 - An anchor chart where students will focus on characters, setting, problem/solution, sequencing, and cause/effect. A great way for students to focus on and learn the different story elements.
- **Jack and the Beanstalk Story Elements Interactive Book**
 - Students will get to create an interactive story elements book that focuses on this story. This book includes different pages that allow students to get hands-on and a deeper understanding of the different story elements.
- **3D Sequence Beanstalk**
 - Students will make a 3D beanstalk craft that focuses on the beginning/middle/end of the story. The beanstalk stands up on it's own too!

What is included continued...

- **Create a Class Book- What Would You Buy with Magic Beans?**
 - Students will get to write about what they would buy with magic beans. Turn the writing into a class book. This writing also has a fun interactive twist!
- **Would You Rather Have Magic Beans or Money? Class Graph and Data**
 - Students will choose if they would rather have magic beans or money. Make a large class graph and fill in data to go with the graph.
- **Would You Rather Have Magic Beans or Money? Writing Craftivity**
 - Students will write about whether they would rather have magic beans or money and why. They will also get to make a craft to go with their writing.
- **Board Game**
 - Students will get to play a fun game while focusing on a particular skill of your choice. (6 to choose from: letters, sight words, beginnings sounds, or CVC words, addition, subtraction)
- **Shape Castle**
 - Students will get to build a castle using different shapes! They will also get to graph and record the data on how many of each shape they used to build their castle.
- **Comparing with a Giant Foot and Hand**
 - Students get to measure a giant foot, a giant hand, and their own foot and hand. Not only will they measure both, but they will get to compare their hand and foot to the giant hand and foot!
- **Top of the Beanstalk Prediction**
 - Students will make a prediction about what Jack will find at the top of the beanstalk.

What is included continued...

- **Comparing Stories Anchor Chart and Venn Diagram Activity**
 - A Venn Diagram anchor chart to compare both stories and a follow up Venn Diagram Activity to compare the stories, 'Jack and the Beanstalk' and 'Trust Me, Jack's Beanstalk Stinks!'.
- **Favorite Story Writing Craftivity**
 - After reading both stories, 'Jack and the Beanstalk' and 'Trust Me, Jack's Beanstalk Stinks!' students will get to write about which story was their favorite and why. They will also get to choose Jack or the Giant to hold their writing.
- **Climbing a Beanstalk Writing Craftivity**
 - Students will write about what they would find at the top of a giant beanstalk. They will make a craft of themselves climbing a beanstalk to go with their writing!
- **Roll and Cover**
 - Choose from playing with 1 or 2 dice. The first one to cover the numbers on the beanstalk wins!
- **Measuring with Beans**
 - Students will get to measure different pictures from the story using bean sticks (provided) or REAL beans or jelly beans.
- **Magic Beans Game**
 - 2 options to choose from: letters or sight words. (blank beans are provided for you to write sight words of your choice).
- **Magic Beans Label**
 - Finish the unit by giving students their very own 'Magic Beans' (jelly beans). A label is provided for these beans!



Each activity comes with step-by-step details and instructions on how to prep, complete, and teach the activity.
