



# Little Red Riding Hood

This pack is FULL of fun, hands-on, and interactive activities that go along with the classic fairy tale, 'Little Red Riding Hood'. There are literacy and math activities, anchor charts, crafts, and MORE!

This will pack will really get students a deeper understanding of the different story elements while having a blast!

**The activities in this unit go along with these stories:**

- 'Red Riding Hood' by James Marshall
- Other versions of 'Little Red Riding Hood'
- 'Lon Po Po' by Ed Young
- 'Honestly, Red Riding Hood Was Rotten!' by Trisha Speed Shaskan

**\*\*I have made the activities so that you can use ALL or some of these books above.**



**Here is what is included:**

- **(Little) Red Riding Hood Story Map Anchor Chart**
  - An anchor chart where students will focus on characters, setting, problem, solution, sequencing, and beginning/middle/end. A great way for students to focus on and learn the different story elements.
- **(Little) Red Riding Hood Story Elements Interactive Book**
  - Students will get to create an interactive story elements book that focuses on this story. This book includes different pages that allow students to get hands-on and a deeper understanding of the different story elements.

## What is included continued:

- **3D Basket Craftivity**
  - Students will make a 3D basket craft that focuses on the beginning/ middle/end of the story OR that retells the story. (2 to choose from)
- **Board Game**
  - Students will get to play a fun game while focusing on a particular skill of your choice. (4 to choose from: letters, sight words, beginnings sounds, or CVC words)
- **Create a Class Book- What Would You Bring Grandmother?**
  - Students will get to write about what they would bring Granny/ Grandmother. Turn the writing into a class book. This writing also has a fun interactive twist!
- **Red Riding Hood and Wolf Craft**
  - Make Little Red Riding Hood and/or the Wolf craft.
- **What Would You Do? Writing Activity**
  - Students will write about what they would do if they saw the wolf. This writing also has a little interactive twist!
- **Mystery Puzzles**
  - Students will build a mystery puzzle while working on a specific skill! 5 different mystery puzzles. Skills included are: Beginning Sounds, CVC Words, Counting 0-10, Counting 10-20, and addition.
- **Would You Walk Through the Dark Woods/Forest Alone Graph & Data**
  - Students will choose whether or not what would walk through the dark woods/forest alone. Make a large class graph and fill in data to go with the graph.
- **Counting/Addition Mini Reader**
  - 2 mini readers to choose from. 1.) Count the pictures and write the number to make the sentence complete. 2.) Count the pictures, write the numbers to make the sentences complete, and write an addition equation to go with the sentences.



## What is included continued:

- **Spin and Graph**
  - Students will spin and graph different characters. Multiple options to choose from.
- **Who Do You Believe Graph, Data, and Writing**
  - After hearing Little Red Riding Hood and the Wolf's versions of the story, it is time for students to decide which version they believe! Make a large class graph, fill in data to go with the graph, and write about why they choose to believe that character.
- **Who Do You Believe Craft**
  - A fun craft for students to make and show which version of the story they believe.
- **Comparing Lon Po Po and (Little) Red Riding Hood Anchor Chart and Activities**
  - A Venn Diagram anchor chart to compare both stories and different follow up activities for students to do. (Venn Diagrams and flip books)
- **Comparing Stories Anchor Chart**
  - Students will get to compare different versions of the story. (Red Riding Hood/Little Red Riding Hood, Lon Po Po, Honestly Red Riding Hood Was Rotten-compare all of the stories or just a couple.)
- **Favorite Story Writing Activity**
  - An interactive activity where students write about their favorite version of the story.

**Each activity comes with step-by-step details and instructions on how to prep, complete, and teach the activity. ALL colored images and pages also come in black and white.**
