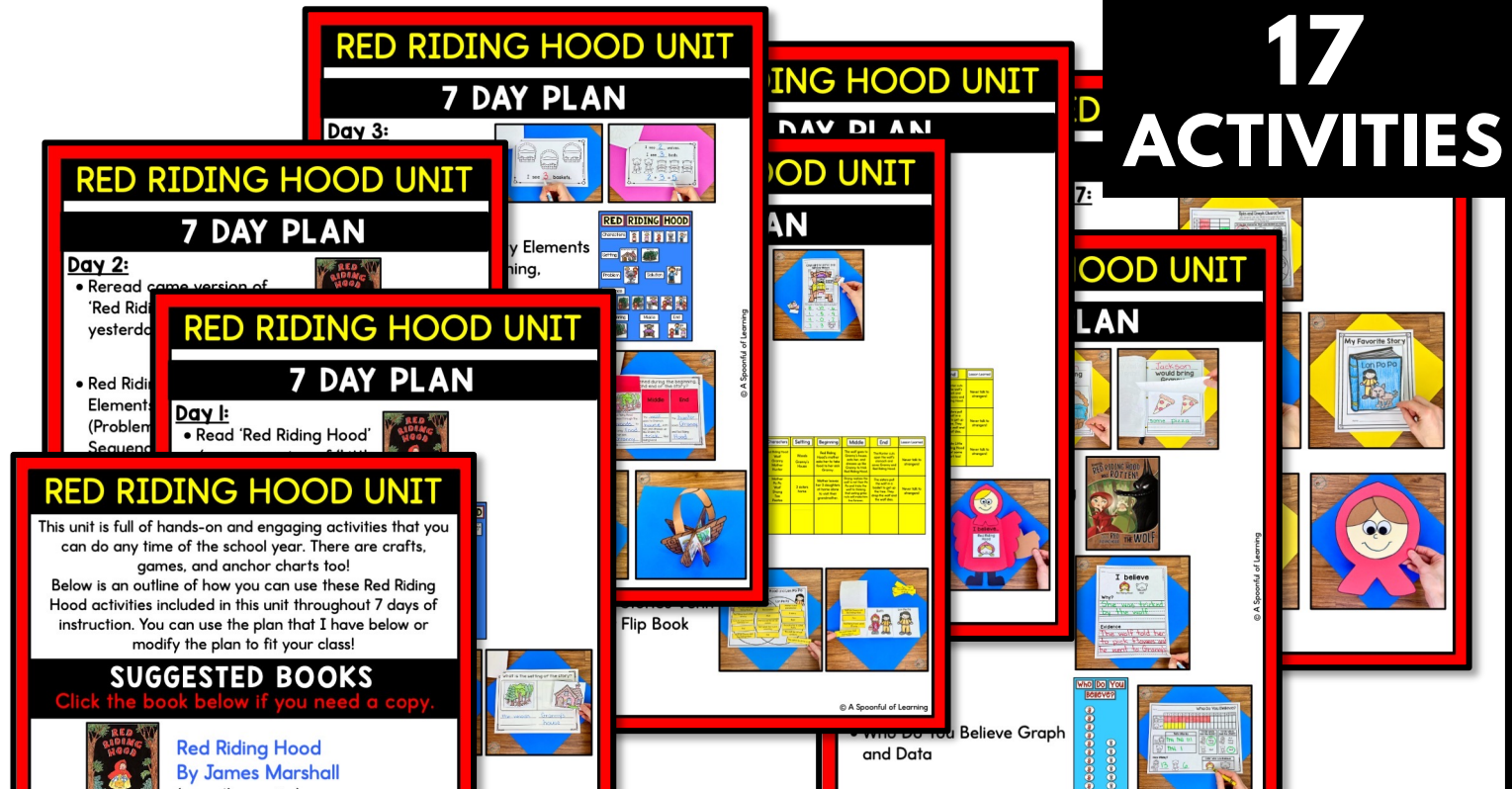

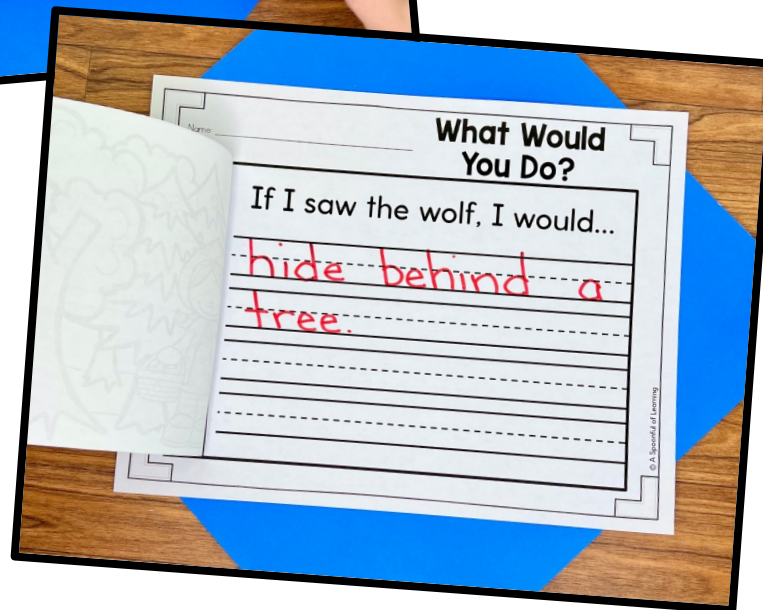

Dive deep into the story and learn about the different story elements. This interactive student book focuses on the characters, setting, problem/solution, sequencing, and cause/effect.

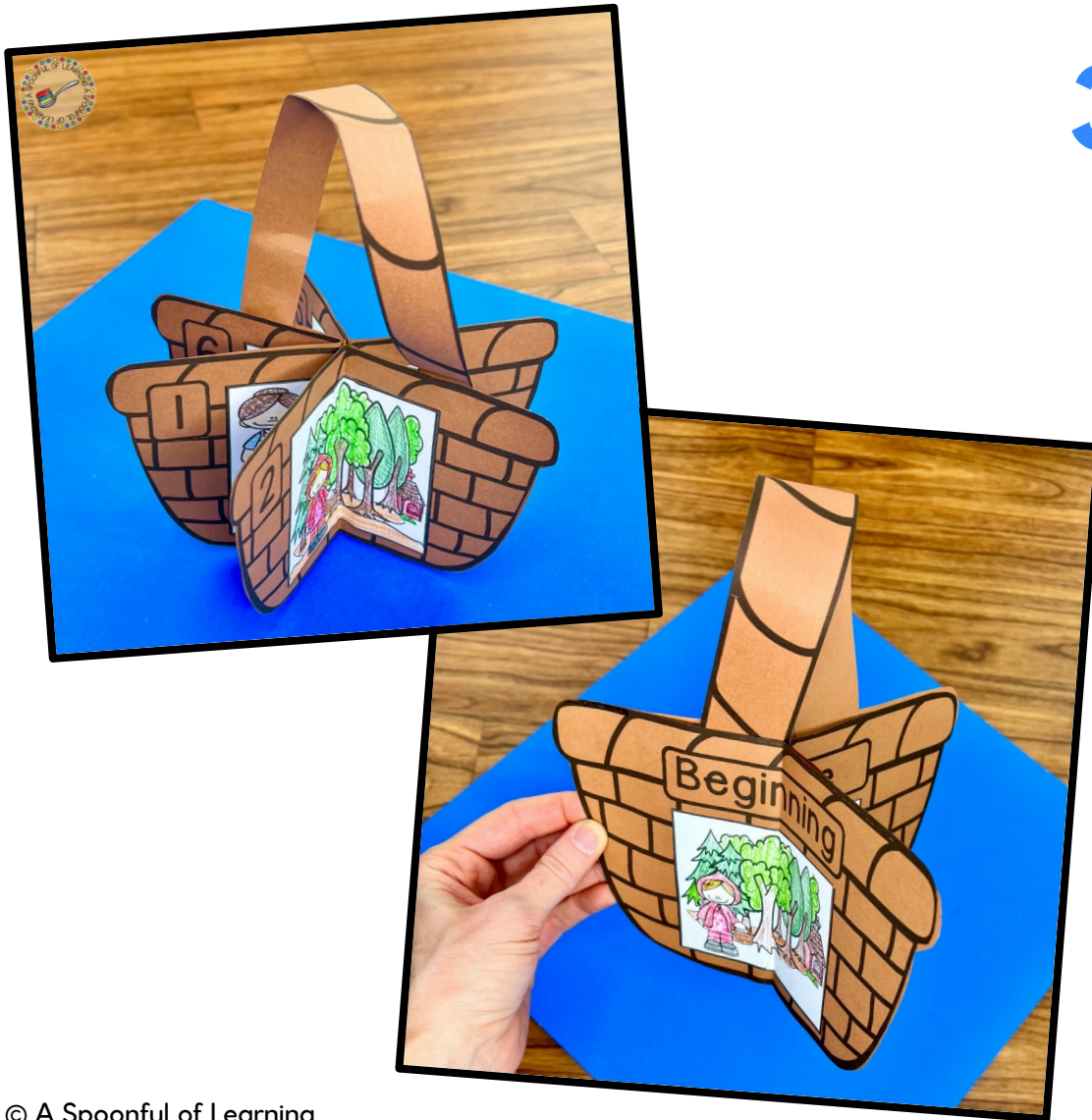

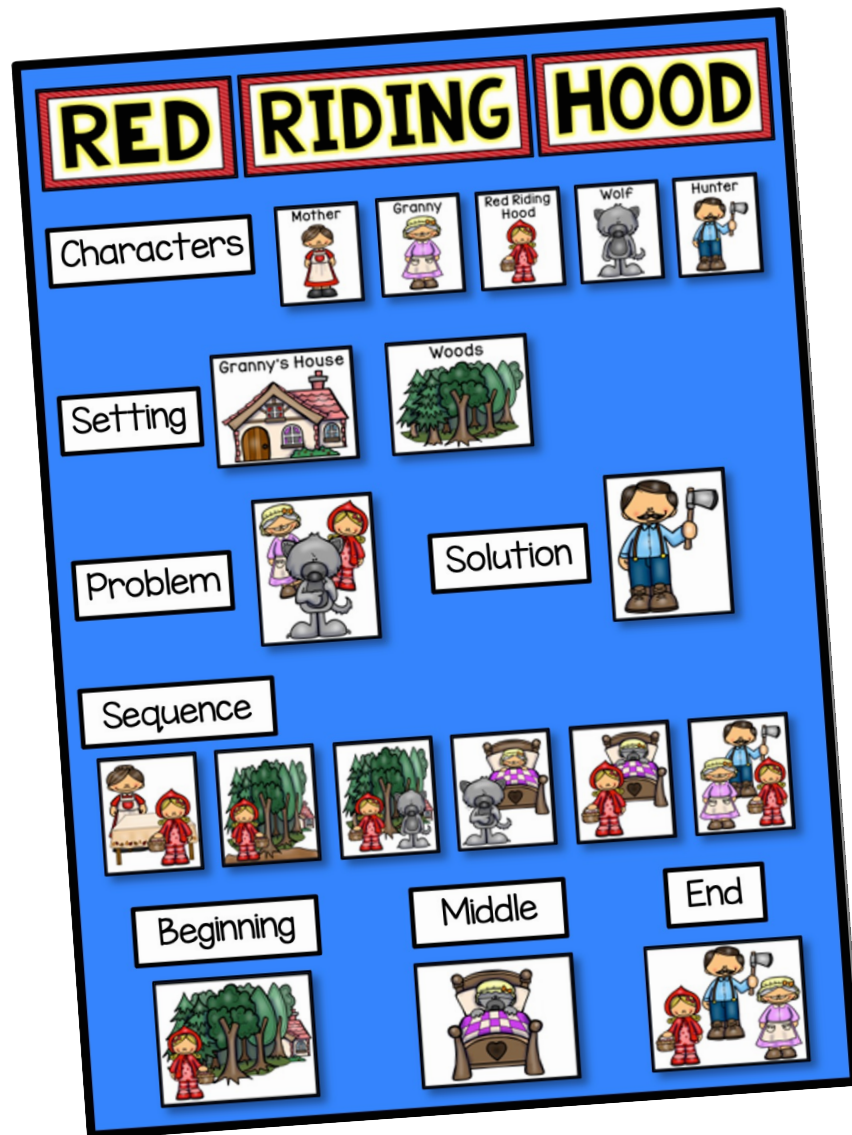
WRITING CLASS BOOK

STORY ELEMENTS ANCHOR CHART

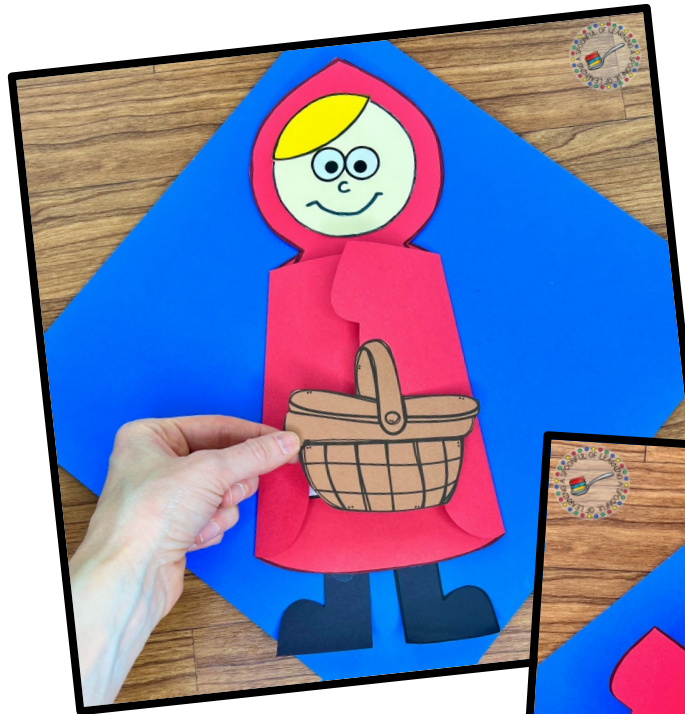
Work together as a class to create an anchor chart that focuses on the different story elements of Red Riding Hood.

After reading about two different points of view on what really happened with Red Riding Hood, students get to show who they believe with a craft.

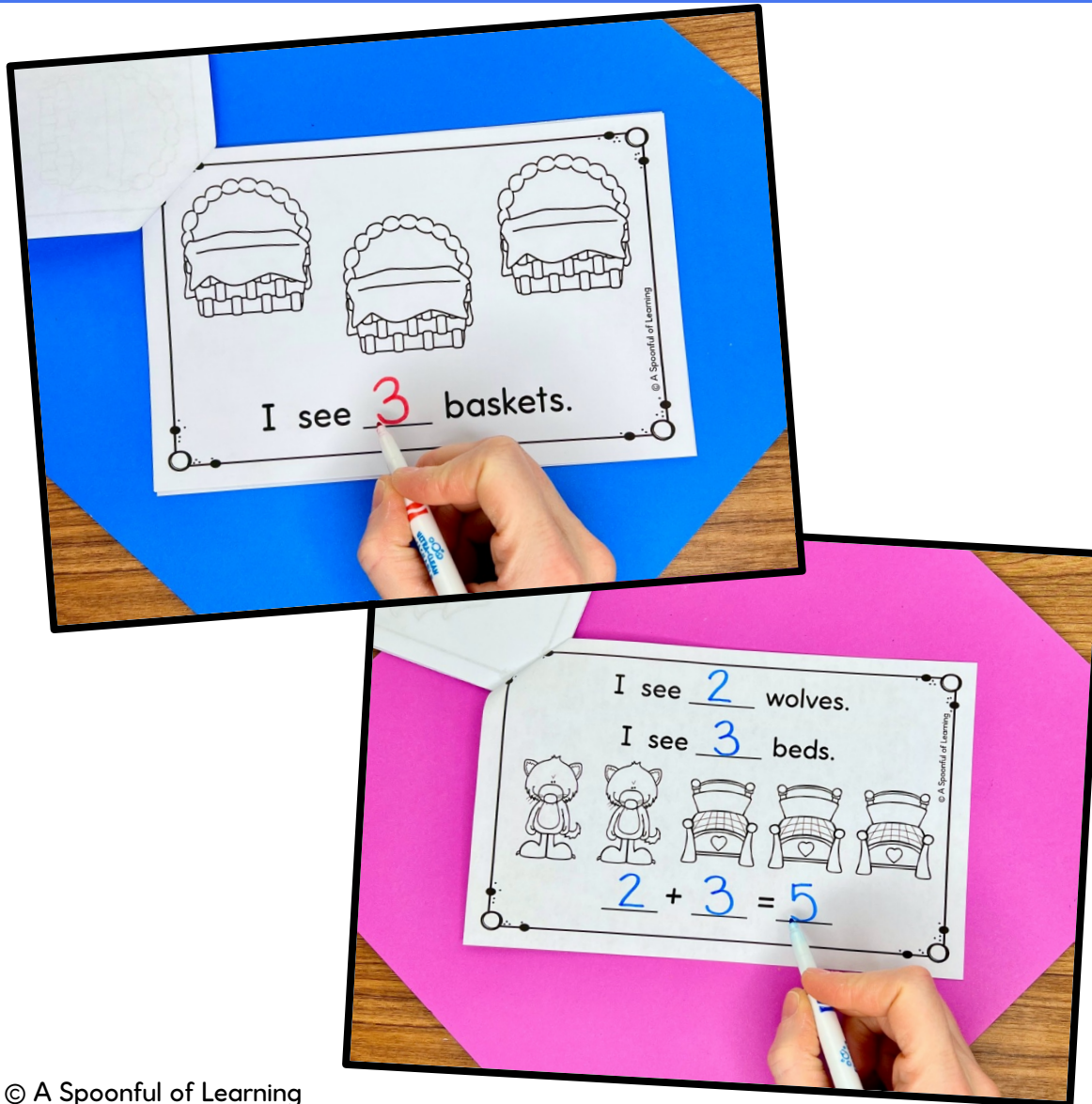

WHO DO YOU BELIEVE WRITING

After reading about two different points of view on what really happened with Red Riding Hood, students get to write about who they believe. They also get to write about the evidence as to why they believe a certain point of view.

Play a game with friends while practicing different skills of your choice: sight words, CVC words, beginning sounds, and letters A-Z

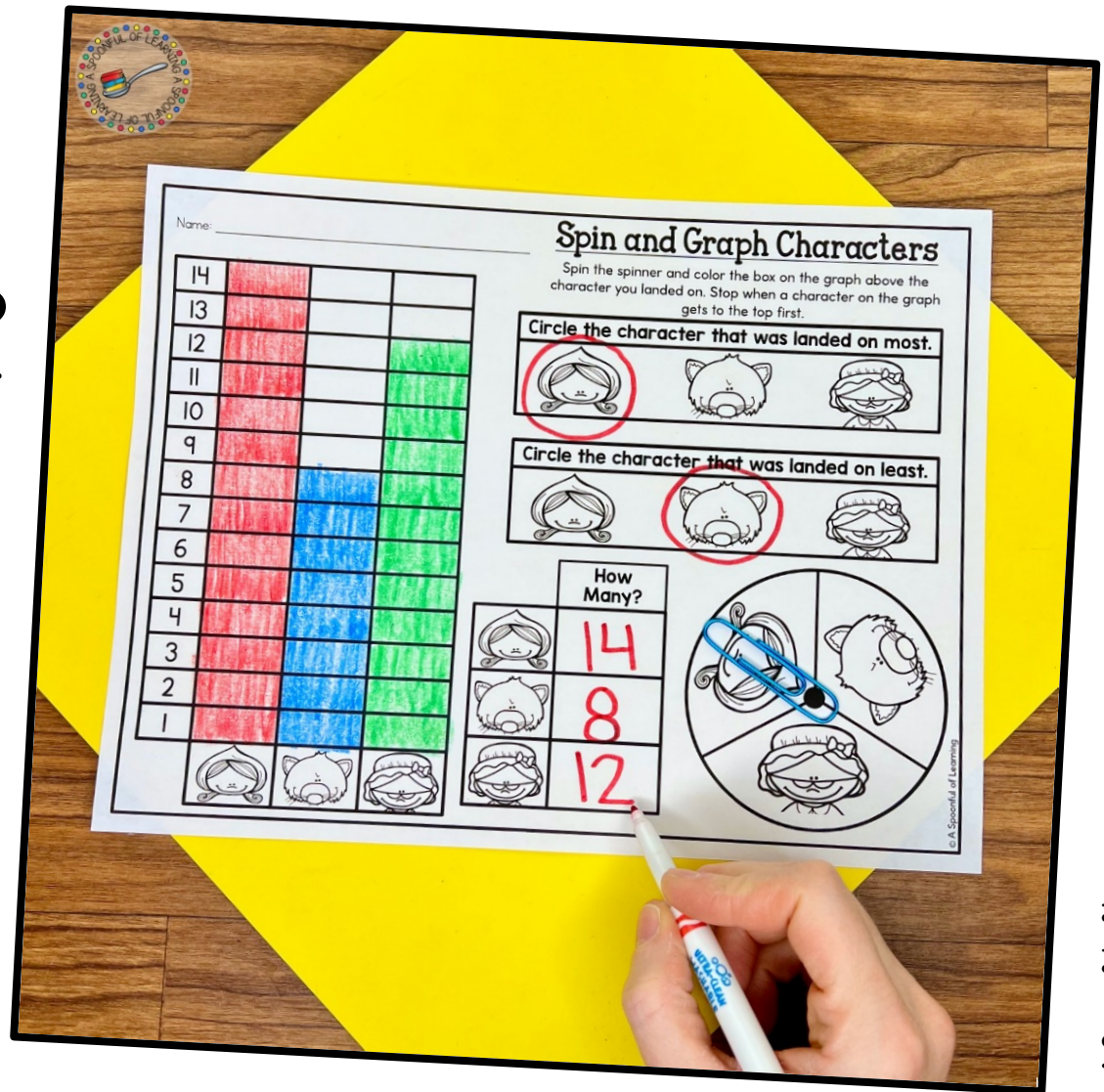

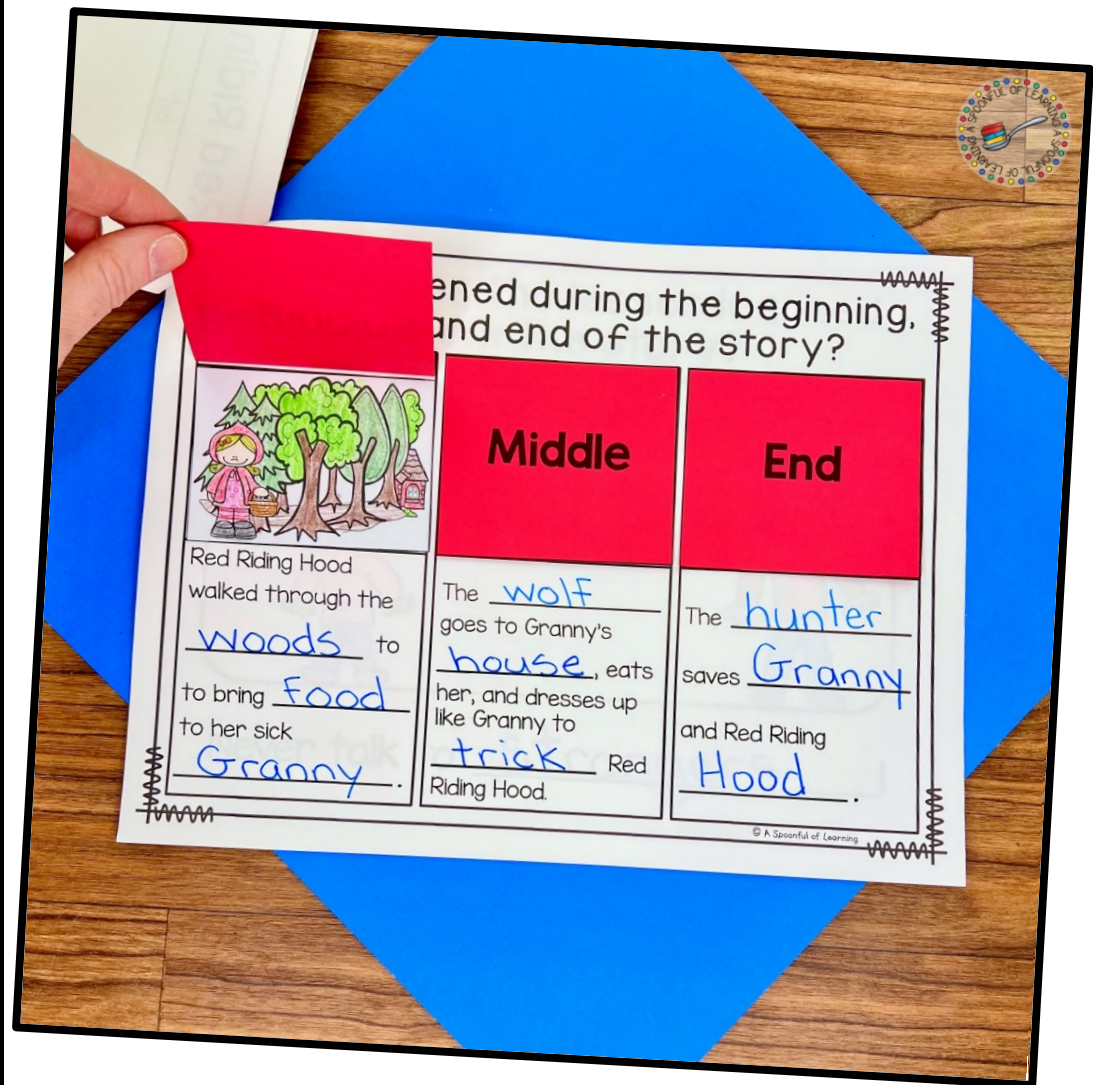

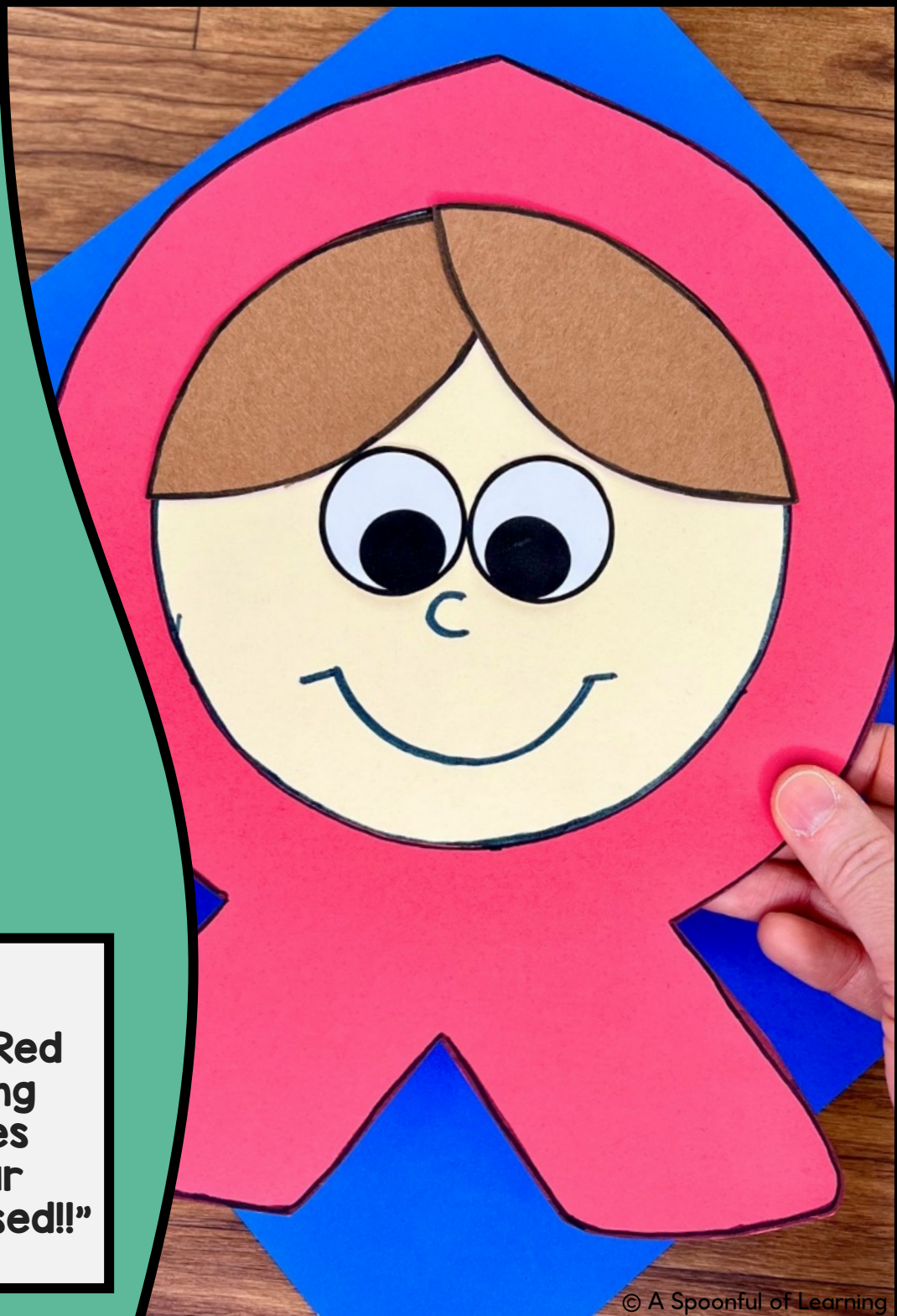
