



Dive deep into the story and learn about the different story elements. This interactive student book focuses on the characters, setting, problem/solution, sequencing, and cause/effect.




3D SEQUENCING BASKET

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
WRITING CLASS BOOK



Practice opinion writing when students get to write about their favorite story. 3 different stories to choose from.






STORY ELEMENTS ANCHOR CHART

After reading about two different points of view on what really happened with Red Riding Hood, students get to show who they believe with a craft.






MATH MINI READERS

Choose from a counting or addition reader where students use the pictures on the pages to fill in the blanks to make complete sentences.


WHO DO YOU BELIEVE WRITING


BOARD GAME


Play a game with friends while practicing different skills of your choice: sight words, CVC words, beginning sounds, and letters A-Z



SPIN & GRAPH


Use a paperclip spinner to spin and land on different characters. Graph the result and answer the questions. There are 3 different options and levels of difficulty to choose from.


