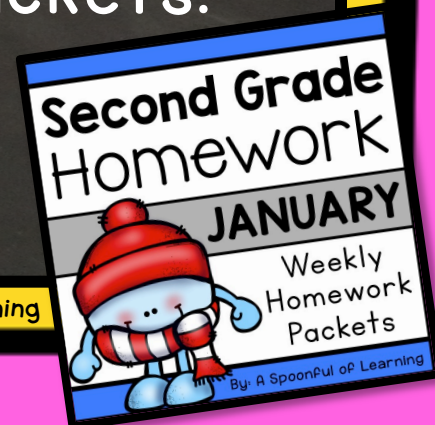

January Homework- Week 1

Math Common Core Standards:

- **2.NBT.A1B** - The numbers 100, 200, 300, 400, 500, 600, 700, 800, 900 refer to one, two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight, or nine hundreds (and 0 tens and 0 ones).
- **2.NBT.A2** - Count within 1000; skip-count by 5's, 10's, and 100's.
- **2.NBT.A3** - Read and write numbers to 1000 using base-ten numerals, number names, and expanded form.
- **2.NBT.B5** - Fluently add and subtract within 100 using strategies based on place value, properties of operations, and/or the relationship between addition and subtraction.
- **2.NBT.B6** - Add up to four two-digit numbers using strategies based on place value and properties of operations.
- **2.NBT.B8** - Mentally add 10 or 100 to a given number 100-900, and mentally subtract 10 or 100 from a given number 100-900.

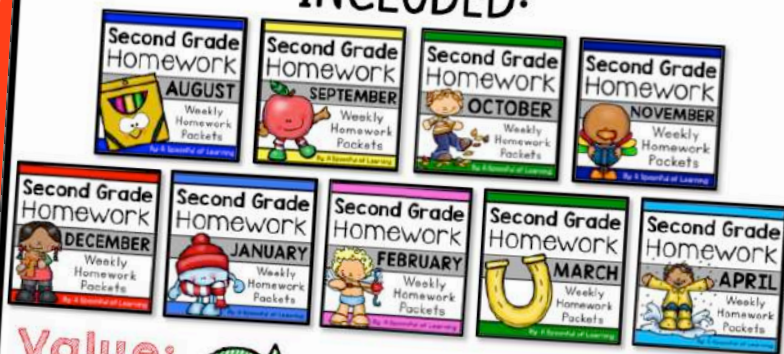

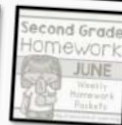
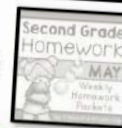
