



St. Patrick's Day Fun!

This unit is packed with hands-on, engaging, math, literacy, and writing activities all related to St. Patrick's Day! There is a week worth of activities in this unit. There are crafts and anchor charts too! These activities go along with the common core in literacy, writing, and math.

Here is what is all included:

MATH ACTIVITIES:

• Get that Gold! Addition & Subtraction Game

- A fun board game where students have to solve addition and subtraction equations to move towards the pot of gold. The first one there wins! Be careful of that sneaky Leprechaun though!

• Leprechaun Addition Craftivity

- Students will make a cute Leprechaun craft with addition equations on golden coins and the sum inside a pot of gold!

• My Lucky Addition Stories Book

- This is a hands-on, cut and glue addition storybook with 5 different addition stories for students to solve.

• Leprechaun Graph, Data, & Writing

- Your students will get to collect their own data, make a class pie chart on whether or not they believe in Leprechauns, and record the class data.

• Pot of Gold Add & Subtract

- Students will solve addition, subtraction, or addition/subtraction equations combined on pots of gold! They will match it to the answer on the coin and glue it to flip up!

• Stealing Golden Coins Subtraction

- Students will practice acting out subtraction equations with manipulatives: 'golden coins'. The Leprechaun steals the gold and students need to determine how many are left!

• Lucky Subtraction Stories

- This is a hands-on, cut and glue addition storybook with 5 different addition stories for students to solve.

• Skittles Sort & Graph

- A tasty activity where students will get to sort skittles, graph the results, and write information to go with the graph such as: write the number, make tallies, compare, and add different colors!

LITERACY & WRITING ACTIVITIES:

- **Clover CVC or CVCC/CCVC Room Search**
 - Students will walk around the class searching for four leaf clovers! When they find one they will say the picture name and write the word on the recording sheet.
- **Leprechaun Informational Chart**
 - Make a class informational anchor chart about what Leprechauns can do, have, and are. Students will also make their own chart.
- **Leprechaun Informational Writing Flip Book**
 - Students use the informational chart that they made about Leprechauns to write sentences in a flip book all about Leprechauns!
- **Leprechaun Story Writing Organizer**
 - Students will organize their thoughts and ideas on this writing organizer to prepare them to write their own story about a Leprechaun who lost his pot of gold.
- **Leprechaun Writing Story & Craftivity**
 - Students will write their very own Leprechaun story! They will also do a craftivity for the cover of their book with a painted rainbow and Leprechaun coming out of a pot of gold!
- **Pot of Gold Sight Word Game**
 - Students will play this hands-on game where they read sight words on golden coins to place on their pot. Don't get the Leprechaun or he will steal all of the gold!
- **Where is My Pot of Gold Mini Reader**
 - Students will follow along with repetitive sentences and sight words in this original mini reader about a Leprechaun who lost his pot of gold!

This St. Patrick's Day Unit also comes with a 'Unit At-A-Glance' that gives you a week long layout of when you can do all of these activities in your class. This helps as a great guide for planning!

Each activity comes with step-by-step details and instructions on how to prep, complete, and teach the activity. There are pictures of each completed activity for you to see exactly how to use it.
